## **Basic Facts**


- No flags
- Two whistles
- Referees have to be able to work together effectively
- Eye contact is essential


## **Points of Emphasis**

- When trail referee's team is attacking, trail referee needs to advance more up the field
- When trail referee's team is defending, trail referee should be moving toward his goal and watching for offsides
- Officials should work together to minimize distance between each other

## **Potential Issues with Dual System**


- Not in best position to see fouls/misconduct in the middle of the field
- Not in position to see fouls/misconduct on opposite side from where official is positioned
- Communication between referees
- Officials contradicting each other on calls
- Managing substitutions
