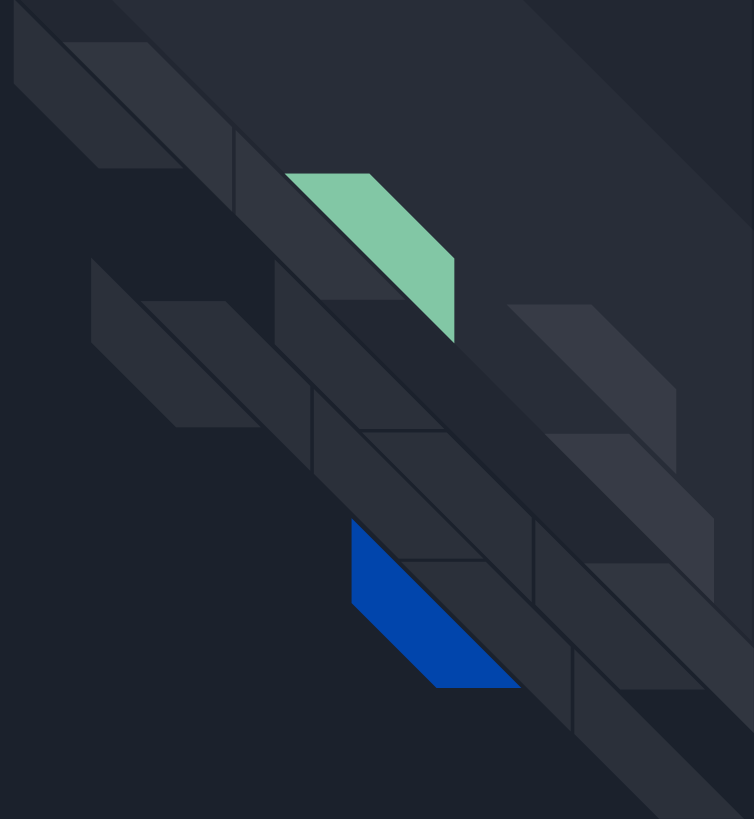
A Team area out of control will only bring problems. Your goal as a Referee is to change or influence the behaviour.
